



UPCOMING UTILITY WORK AT UNION STREET

OCTOBER 2020

Starting as early as November 16, Union Street between Alaskan Way and Western Ave will be partially obstructed by construction to install underground electric utilities. This will also require a month-long closure of the stairs at Union Street connecting Western Ave and Alaskan Way during work hours. Work is anticipated to wrap up in late January 2021.

WORK ZONES

- Union Street between Alaskan Way and Western Avenue
- Private construction at Public Storage begins in early November

SCHEDULE AND HOURS

- Monday-Friday, 7 AM to 5 PM
- Occasional weekend work

PEDESTRIAN AND VEHICLE ACCESS

- Stairs at Union Street connecting Western Ave and Alaskan Way closed during work hours
- Pedestrian access between Alaskan Way and Western Avenue will be maintained via University Street and the Pike Street Hillclimb
- Access to businesses will be maintained

EQUIPMENT AND NOISE

- Work will include saw cutting, excavation, dewatering and utility installation

PARKING AND LOAD ZONES

- Access to Public Storage loading docks will be maintained, large vehicles may need to park at an angle
- Access to Seattle Antiques and Hillclimb Garage parking north of Union Street will be maintained
