

As early as November 16, traffic lanes on Alaskan Way between Pike and Pine streets will be significantly reduced to install underground utilities. This utility work is anticipated to take up to four weeks and has been advanced to support coordination with the Aquarium's future Ocean Pavilion expansion. All lanes will reopen at 3 PM each day. Detour signage and flaggers will be on site to direct vehicles and pedestrians. Activities will include breaking pavement, excavation and utility installation.

## **WORK ZONE:**

Alaskan Way between Pike and Pine streets

### **SCHEDULE AND HOURS:**

- Monday through Friday, 7 AM to 3 PM
- Any necessary overnight and weekend work will be communicated in advance

# **PEDESTRIAN AND VEHICLE ACCESS:**


- As early as November 16, Alaskan Way reduced to one lane from 9 AM to 3 PM daily for 1 week, flaggers will maintain and direct two-way traffic
- As early as November 23, Alaskan Way reduced to two lanes from 7 AM to 3 PM daily for up to 3 weeks, flaggers will maintain and direct two-way traffic
- As early as November 30, Pine St at Alaskan Way reduced to one lane, flaggers will maintain and direct two-way traffic
- Expect temporary closures of sidewalk and crosswalk at Pine St, pedestrian access along Alaskan Way between Pike and Pine streets will be maintained on the west side sidewalk.

## **EQUIPMENT AND NOISE:**

- Expect construction equipment and vehicles moving in and out of the work zone
- Construction trucks and equipment may be noisy, with the most significant noise coming from breaking and removing roadway pavement

## **PARKING AND LOAD ZONES:**

- Access to Pike Place Market garage entrance at Pike St and exit at Pine St will be maintained
- No impacts to on-street parking and load zones
